2015 SIMULTANEOUS SCHOOL AND DISTRICT CAMPORALS

- Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 76 entitled "Revitalizing Boy Scouting in School" which
 intends to develop boys and young men into well rounded individuals with
 exemplary character worth the emulation of school children, this division will
 conduct a 2015 SIMULTANEOUS SCHOOLS & DISTRICT CAMPORALS on October 2325, 2015 with the theme: "Peace and Development through Scouting".
- The activities is designed in order to generate enthusiasm, enhance the creative energy and improved competences to the scouts as preparation to the incoming major activities or events in the Local, Regional, National and International Scouting activities.
- 3. The 2015 SIMULTANEOUS SCHOOL AND DISTRICT CAMPORALS aims to:
 - Demonstrate typical scouting activities and the need for intelligent coordination of efforts through boy leadership;
 - b. Understand the necessity for discipline, self-reliant citizens and good order;
 - c. Demonstrate and practice the technique of "learning by doing" by immediate application of skills and knowledge;
 - d. Direct the boy's attention in a practical way towards the opportunities for leadership in Scouting;
 - e. Give more opportunities to less fortunate but deserving scouts experience the scouting activities; and
 - f. Increase BSP Scouts Membership.
- 4. The Districts/Elementary & Secondary Schools principals are encouraged to have at least 20% minimum participation of student's potential/enrolled during the year.
- 5. The Camporal Fee of PhP100.00/participant to cover BSP membership (PhP50.00), Training Materials, Certificate and other administrative expenses shall be charged to

- school funds, PTA, LGU/SEF and other funds subject to its availability and to the usual COA accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. The participants shall report to the designated venue on October 2, 2015 at 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon (see attached references and guidance). They advise to bring the following:
 - a. Type A and B Uniform (Type A uniform is optional);
 - BSP Boy (Elementary-Green) and Senior Scouts (High School Red) Neckerchief and slide;
 - c. Clothes for 3 days;
 - d. Writing materials;
 - e. Tent with sleeping gears;
 - f. Toiletries and personal belongings;
 - g. Foods and drinking water for 3 days;
 - Individual or patrol/crew cooking pot and firewood for backwoods cooking is encouraged and compulsory;
 - i. Kitchen and cooking utensils;
 - j. Scout knife;
 - k. Rope;
 - l. Musical Instrument(optional)
 - m. Flashlight
- 7. After the conduct of the said activity, written report is required to submit to the division Office on or before the 1st week of November 2015, c/o Mr. Roldan B. Calapiz, Social Mobilization and Networking Unit for evaluation and recommendation to the Office of the Schools Division Superintendent for future awards and merit.
- 8. The teachers who serve in this camporal shall be given two (2) days service credit and subject to the provision stipulated under DECS memorandum No. 143, s. 1997.
- 9. For widest dissemination and strict compliance of this memorandum is directed.
