

Subject: Three-Day Live-In Capacity Training Skills Cum Workshop for District ALIVE Coordinators (DIACs) and ALIVE Teachers

Date: March 15, 2016

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 57, s. 2010 mandating the implementation of the Basic Education Madrasah Programs for Muslim Out-School-Youth and Adults, as a response to the call for global commitment on Education for All (EFA) Goal. Thus, this office under the Alternative Learning System (ALS) will conduct a 3-Day Live-In Capacity Training Skills Cum Workshop For District ALIVE Coordinators (DIACs) and ALIVE Teachers of this Division on April 6-8, 2016 with the following purposes stated under :
 - a. Provide opportunities to have a deeper understanding about DepEd Order No. 57, s. 2010 and Division Memorandum No. __, s. 2016 – Implementation of the Basic Madrasah Program for Muslim Out-of-School Youth and Adults and Mandating Contractual ASATIDZ to cater ALS-ALIVE Program ;
 - b. Impart to the participants the Philippine Roadmap for Enriching Muslim Basic Education Updates;
 - c. Orient the participants on their roles and functions as ALS-ALIVE Implementers;
 - d. Capacitate District ALIVE Coordinators (DIACs) and ALIVE Teachers on the ALS-ALIVE Advocacy , Literacy Mapping and Learning sessions;
 - e. Vest ALS-ALIVE Implementers the competence on the different Teaching Strategies using ALS-ALIVE Modules;
 - f. Experience the actual ALS-ALIVE Activities (i.e. ADSOCMOB and Literacy Mapping) through MOA (Mentor, Orient and Advocate) Program and ;
 - g. Provide the necessary information on the different ALS Programs and Projects;

2. The participants to this activity are the EPS II-ALS, selected District ALS Coordinators (DALSCs), District ALIVE Coordinators (DACs), and ALIVE Teachers, they are expected to check-in at the venue at 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon on April 5, 2016 and check-out time will be 12:00nn on April 8, 2016. Dinner as first meal will be served on April 5, 2016.

3. The EPS II - ALS and identified facilitators are required to be at the venue on April 5, 2016 for the preparation and Pre-Planning activity.
4. Transportation expenses incurred by the EPS II-ALS, facilitators and participants relative to their participation to this activity shall be charged to the Division INSET Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Venue for this seminar will be announced later.
