**ADDITION OF GUTALAC NHS IN THE LIST OF SCHOOLS  
OFFERING JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY,  
ENGINEERING AND MATHEMATICS (STEM) PROGRAM**

1. In line with the government's policy of upgrading science and engineering education in the country, all institutions, programs and outputs in the form of science and engineering should be streamlined to produce graduates who could support the requirements of industry and impact technological and economic development.
2. In order to bring forth this objective into all out reality, there is a need to continuously attain higher level of quality education in the secondary schools offering S & T Oriented (ESEP)/SSC/STEM curricula.
3. In this connection, this division is adding Gutalac NHS in the list of schools offering Junior High School STEM curriculum. Thus, to date, there are 13 schools categorized as ESEP B and one as ESEP A. Namely: ESEP/SSC/STEM A: Sindangan NHS, ESEP/SSC/STEM B: Gutalac NHS, Bacungan NHS, Polanco NHS, Sirawai NHS, Sibuco NHS, Siocon NHS, Tampilisan NHS, Ubay NHS, Liloy NHS, Manukan NHS, Salug NHS and Katipunan NHS (SY 2014-2015).
