Subject: **ACCEPTANCE OF TAHDERIYYA PROGRAM COMPLETERS FROM
COMMUNITY-BASED SCHOOLS TO GRADE 1**

Date: July 21, 2016

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memoranda No. 36, series 2013 and DM-CI-2016-00102, the Tahderiyya Curriculum for Non-DepEd Schools (*BDA Operated Islamic Community Schools*), has been developed through the collaborative effort of Bangsamoro Development Agency (BDA), Community of Learners Foundation, United Nation Children's Fund (UNICEF) and DepEd, the standards and competencies are aligned with the Forty-Week National Kindergarten Curriculum implemented nationwide.
2. As articulated in DM-CI-2016-00102, all concerned schools are advised to accept the Tahderiyya Learner Completers to Grade 1 while waiting for the results of validation assessment in connection with their Learner Reference Number (LRN) entry. The validation is to be conducted by the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA) from July to August 2016. Should the learner fail the said validation, appropriate intervention/remediation shall be done.
3. The concerned community-based schools operating the program are advised to take necessary steps in securing a permit to operate and to submit a copy to this office and to public elementary schools where these learners may enrol to prevent denial entry of their completers due to the absence of their LRN.
4. The Tahderiyya Curriculum is complimenting the Madrasah Kindergarten Curriculum implemented in all public schools under the ALIVE Program and in assisted private madrasah.
5. Widest and immediate dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is hereby desired.

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

SUBJECT : ACCEPTANCE OF *TAHDERIYYAH* PROGRAM COMPLETERS
FROM COMMUNITY-BASED SCHOOLS TO GRADE 1

DATE : June 27, 2016

According to the Bangsamoro Development Agency (BDA), there are some cases in your region where *Tahderiyyah* learner completers from community-based schools are denied entry to Grade 1 due to the absence of the learner reference number (LRN). While *Tahderiyyah* is a DepEd recognized curriculum, as per DepEd Memorandum No. 36, s. 2013, and is being implemented by BDA with the technical support from the UNICEF, these learners should take the validation assessment to be conducted by the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA) from July to August 2016.

However, for school year 2016-2017, since it takes time for the *Tahderiyyah* completers to undergo the validation assessment process, all concerned schools are advised to accept the said learners to Grade 1 while waiting for the results of the validation test. Should the learner fail the validation assessment, appropriate intervention/remediation shall be done.

The concerned community-based schools are advised to take necessary steps in securing a permit to operate to prevent such things from happening again in the succeeding school years.

For your information and immediate action

4. In view of the foregoing, DepEd recommends for its use in non-DepEd schools under the BDA Operated Islamic Community Schools and private *madaris* not receiving the government financial assistance.

5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
