Subject: Conduct of class observation to Sergio Osmeña CS relative to the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Implementation of Grade 4 K to 12 Science Curriculum, and to conduct district conferences for the Districts Supervisors and School Heads of Sergio Osmeña I, Liloy I, Liloy II, Gutalac I, Gutalac II and Labason on how the least learned competencies in grade 6 NAT can be strategically addressed.

Date: March 3, 2016

1. In line with the Fourth Quarter implementation of Grade 4 K to 12 Science Curriculum, observation of classes of those teachers trained in the mass training of Grade 4 teachers will help identify areas of the curriculum where this division can utilize data from the observation of classes which in return can be the bases in providing technical assistance for the teachers in the 2016-2017 forthcoming school year.
2. In addition, there is a necessity to conduct district conferences for the Districts Supervisors and School Heads of Sergio Osmeña I, Liloy I, Liloy II, Gutalac I, Gutalac II and Labason on how the least learned competencies in grade 6 NAT can be strategically addressed.
3. The conference aims to:
  - 3.1. discuss Grade 6 NAT Least Learned competencies;
  - 3.2. undertake activities on how Grade 6 NAT Least Learned competencies can be strategically addressed;
  - 3.3. identify best practices of those schools in the district who obtained high MPS in Grade 6 NAT;
  - 3.4. create a mechanism to sustain or improve Grade 6 NAT results in the forthcoming years.
