QUALIFICATION OF PARTICIPANTS

GIRL:

1. Currently registered Junior/Senior Girl Scout.
2. Must be physically fit and alert.
3. Must have earned at least one badge each under the 8-Point challenge.
4. Must have attended a troop/patrol camp prior this encampment.

ADULT:

1. Currently registered Troop Leader.
2. Preferably a Campcraft certificate Holder.
3. Must be physically fit and alert.

THINGS TO BRING:


The Following personal things of the individual camper should be prepared and be brought at the camp. Campers are advised to travel light; they should bring only what are needed.

Prescribed Medicines	Flashlight
Comfortable working cloths	Whistle
Jogging Pants	Set of Eating Utensils
Sweater/Jacket/Long Sleeves	Writing Materials
Costume for the Presentation by sub-camp	Extra shirts for adventure games
Official Black Shoes	Bedroll or sleeping bag
Sleeping Garments (blanket or malong)	Girl Scout Knife
Insect Repellant	Raincoat/Slipper/Rubber Shoes
PATROL EQUIPMENT	
Cooking Facilities	Materials for camp gadgets
Washing Facilities (pails, basins, detergent and dish towel)	
Food service (platters, bowls, serving items, water jug, or pitchers)	Quarter tent, fly tent for kitchen shed, and plastic bags for waste disposal.
Each patrol will bring their own food provisions in camp.	Rechargeable lamp

Camera/Musical Instruments	Souvenirs/Tokens for exchange with other campers.

Extra Costumes for District Presentations (Talent Shows & other Costumes) based on the tentative program of activities, Sewing Kit. Coloring Materials, Empty Bottle (1.5L) and any accessories for the empty bottle.
