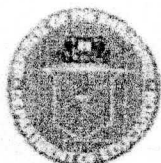

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) in partnership with the Department of Health (DOH) through the School Health Section of SGOD shall implement the Second Round of National Schools Deworming Month for CY 2017 for the whole month of January and July of every year for children 5-18 years old.
2. This activity aims to cover all school age children enrolled in public elementary schools. Private schools interested to participate are advised to coordinate with School Health Personnel in their respective area.
3. School heads and teachers assisted by health personnel are expected to take the lead to ensure success in the implementation of the program.

SUBJECT: **IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NATIONAL SCHOOL DEWORMING
MONTH**

DATE : June 13, 2016

The Department of Education (DepEd) in collaboration with the Department of Health (DOH) and Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) shall implement the National School Deworming Month (NSDM) on July and January of every year for all school children aged 5-17 years old enrolled on both public and private elementary and secondary schools.

NSDM aims to cover more than 85% of the target population to reduce the burden of soil transmitted disease (STD) giving a possible impact in children's health and education.

Massive advocacy campaign shall be undertaken by all stakeholders one month before July (Round 1) and January (Round 2), focusing on the rationale of the program, strategies and procedures, and management and reporting of possible serious adverse events.

Schools Division Superintendents and all division and school personnel from public and private schools are enjoined to fully support the NSDM.
