The Department of Education (DepEd) in collaboration with the Department of Health (DOH) and Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) shall implement the National School Deworming Month (NSDM) on July and January of every year for all school children aged 5-17 years old enrolled on both public and private elementary and secondary schools.

NSDM aims to covier more than 85% of the target population to reduce the burden of soil transmitted disease (STD) giving a possible impact in children's health and education.

Massive advocacy campaign shall be undertaken by all stakeholders one month before July (Round 1) and January (Round 2), focusing on the rationale of the program, strategies and procedures, and management and reporting of possible serious adverse events.

Schools Division Superintendents and all division and school personnel from public and private schools are enjoined to fully support the NSMD.
