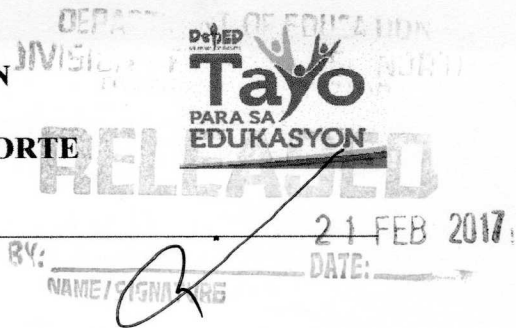

1. Ancillary to **Division Memo nos. 016, 031 and 050**, series **2017**, this memorandum is issued to direct all concerned delegation officials and members, coaches, chaperones, trainers and athletes of both the regular sports and special games for the smooth conduct of the In-house training in Sindangan, ZN and in Dipolog City accordingly from February 26 to March 11, 2017, with the exception of the training schedule for Special Games which was already declared in the earlier memorandum.

3. The Sindangan National Agricultural School shall be the headquarter of the DSAC, Medical Team and the representative working committee members. They may be billeted in the same school, except for the members of the Medical team wherein they have to be clustered and be dispersed to the different billeting schools. Foods to be served by caterer shall be stationed in SNAS, except in cases where the caterer has beforehand been negotiated to deliver the food and snacks to other training venues for a certain period of time.
4. Faithful adherence to the various assignments of quarters and venues by the coaches, chaperones, trainers and trainees is hereby preached. With the knowledge of the athletic head, the training director is however authorized to introduce modifications of the assignments for more effective monitoring of training progress, taking into account the geographical and logistical considerations, as well as the occurrence the circumstances beyond the control of the training steering committee.
5. School heads of the accommodating and host schools are meanwhile enjoined to take pro-active action and support by ensuring that the provisions of usable water, current, rest rooms, clothes-drying areas as well as the vicinity security for the In-housed personnel and athletes are satisfactorily provided. At the outset of billeting, the concerned school heads are authorized to brief the accommodated personnel and athletes about the regulations in place, in order to protect the school's properties and preserve the orderliness of the school physical plant.
6. Catering services and mobilization of athletes for the Special Games during the training are subject to internal arrangements, consonant to their own training matrix and schedule, as was disclosed in the earlier memorandum.
7. Arrival of all athletes, coaches and all other delegation members sanctioned to work during the In-house is expected on the 25th of February 2017. After the dinner, there will be a **third preparatory and consultative meeting with coaches, chaperones, trainers of both the regular sports and special games, and some members of the working committee after the dinner on February 25, 2017, at the SNAS headquarter.** Attendance is a must.
