

The objectives of the activity are the following:

1. To understand the entire scenario of child sexual abuse from child to the family and to the community.
2. To develop awareness and full understanding of the concepts and strategies in teaching Personal Safety Lessons (PSL).
3. To equip the participants with information on how to handle disclosures of sexually abused children.
4. To develop skills and knowledge on the role and functions of the support teams and reporting flow in cases of child abuse.

This is a live-out activity. Training supplies and materials shall be chargeable against CPTCSA funds while travel expenses and meals of the participants shall be chargeable against School MOOE funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
