

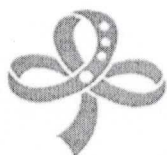

## **DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES**

**INVESTITURE** – Investiture is a time for celebration and well-wishing to a new members. The significance of an investiture ceremony should be impressed upon every troop member, especially on the recruits because they make a very important promise, which aims them to a world-wide fellowship wherein they pledge their responsibilities.

**ORIENTATION** – Organized girl in their patrol, orient them on the day to day Activities for the 3-days Camp and the daily schedule and assign kapers. Inform them of the house rules in the camp.

**MEET NEW FRIENDS & TALENTS UNLIMITED** - A night of Socialization and getting to know each other. This will give our girls a chance to meet new co-girl scouts. Girls will also showcase their different talents.

**GSP REQUIRED SONGS, YELLS & CHEERS** – To introduce Girl Scout Required Songs and a time for them to create their own yells and cheers.

**KNOT TYING AND LASHING** - A lecture on the basic knot tying and lashing

**GADGET MAKING CONTEST** – Contest on making Camp Gadgets, at least 7 camp gadgets for each patrol.

**CREATIVE BOTTLE MAKING** An activity that waste bottle materials into a usable object that will help our environment to reduce consumption of raw materials, energy usage and air & water pollution. Each Girl must bring their 1.5 empty bottle and accessories.

**COOKING CONTEST** – To introduce outdoor cooking without using kitchen utensils.

**CAMP FIRE (INTERNATIONAL NIGHT)** – All Girls must wear their international attire using old cloth or indigenous materials.

**HAND AND WHISTLE SIGNAL** – Lecture on hand and whistle signal.

**POSTER MAKING CONTEST** –A one hour contest for Poster Making with the theme: Today's Girls, Tomorrow's Leaders. Cartolina/Cardboard/Canvass, Size 22 X 30, Watercolor, pastel, crayon

**Twinklers/Star Playday** – The troop leader provides Wide/Obstacle games that suited for the Twinklers (pre-schooler) and Stars(GR. 1-3) to introduce outdoor activities that gives pleasure and encourages friendship among them.

**CAMP VISIT** – Giving the Twinklers and stars an idea of what is outdoor camping and camp set up.
