Subject: **28TH REGIONAL CAMP**

Date: **January 19, 2018**

1. This is in reference to the upcoming **28th Regional Camp** which will be held at **Zamboanga City Economic Zone Authority and Freeport, San Ramon, Zamboanga City on February 7 – 11, 2018.**
2. In view thereof, this office will be sending a total of 264 participants which is composed of 160 Campers, 40 Adult Leaders, 39 Support Staff (SDS, ASDS, Div. GSP Coordinator and District Commissioners) and 15 commissaries and 10 male teachers for the carpentry works (please see Appendix B for the names). Districts or schools are encouraged to send participants to the above mentioned activity with the allowable number of participants as listed in Appendix A and C. Such distribution is proportionate to the number of participants registered per district during the 59th Council Wide Camp held in Liloy CS last November 2017.
3. **The Zamboanga del Norte Provincial Office will sponsor 50% of the registration in the amount of P300.00 to every participant (twinkler, star, junior, senior or adult) while the ZN GSP Council will also appropriate an amount of P150.00 to help cover the participants' miscellaneous expenses. Other estimated expenses like the P900.00 for the round trip transportation and P850 for the 15 meals and 10 snacks of every participant shall be charged against SCHOOL MOOE through cash advance in the name of our ASDS Filma B. Catalan. However, participants from the non-IUs high schools shall get their financial assistance chargeable against the Schools Division Office Funds. In this regard, districts in every patrol are advised to agree as to who are the two adults accountable to lead their patrol. Name of the identified two adults per patrol shall be submitted to this office together with the list of scouts on or before January 30, 2018 to expedite the making of payroll.**
4. Participants (Girl Scouts and Adult Leaders) are advised to provide their own camping equipment aside from the required "things to bring" as stipulated in the attached **Encampment Circular no. 1 s. 2017 re: 28th Regional Encampment and Program of Activities.**
5. Travel and other related expenses incurred by the **support staff, the commissioners and the 10 identified male teachers** shall be charged against the **Division Office Funds** subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Widest dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

ADULT:

1. Currently registered Troop Leader.
2. Preferably a Campcraft Certificate Holder.
3. Must be physically and mentally fit.

Please disseminate the following changes and additional information in preparation for the 28th Regional Camp co-hosted by Zamboanga City Girl Scout Council on February 7-11, 2018 at Zamboanga City Special Economic Zone Authority, San Ramon, Zamboanga City with the theme *"Play, Enjoy and Rediscover"*.

A. Changes/ additional on the program of activities:

1. **Rave Party** - is a large dance party at a festival featuring performances by "Disk Jockey or DJs", who select and mix a seamless flow of loud electronics dance music songs and tracks. Campers can wear comfortable clothes and advised to bring P20.00 as their donation to the "DJs" in this activity.
2. Arts & Craft - "Turbans Making" changed to **"Pouch Making"** activity;
3. Titas Night - changed to "Zumba" on February 8, 2018 at 6:00 o'clock in the morning with the City Mayor of Zamboanga. Troop/ Adult Leaders are advised to bring "Zumba Fitness Attire";

B. Reminder:

1. Fare of P100.00 will be collected per camper/ trip for participants who will arrange for transportation to and from the Bus Terminal to campsite (ECOZONE). However, Councils have to inform the Regional Office or Zamboanga City GS Council one week before their arrivals.
2. Campers who wish to explore Zamboanga City are advised to come early or depart late.
3. Male chaperones are not allowed to stay with the girls in camp.
4. Area for drivers and vehicles will be provided near the entrance of ECOZONE
5. Wet market is provided inside the camp.
6. The Regional Office will accept advance registration fee for Campers to avail the group Insurance while travelling from their respective places to Zamboanga City
