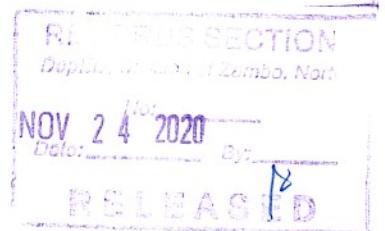

Date: November 23, 2020

1. The Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging and Re-Emerging Infectious Diseases (Task Force COVID-19) of the Province of Zamboanga del Norte recently issued Executive Order No. 20-101, Section 9 thereof provides that mass gatherings such as but not limited to, movie screenings, concert, sporting events, and other entertainment activities, and work conferences shall be allowed at a maximum of fifty percent (50%) of the seating or venue capacity and that minimum public health standards such as wearing of face masks and face shield and the maintenance of social distancing protocols shall be observed. With this development, the supposedly scheduled **Division Writeshop on the Contextualization of ALS Lessons for the Implementation of Program CLOCK** on April 1-3, 2020 shall be conducted on December 2-4, 2020 at a venue which will be announced later after procurement procedure shall be done.

2. The objectives of this writeshop are to:

- a. localize the lesson at the context of the learners
- b. enhance ALS learning resources to be used during instructional delivery
- c. value the importance of localization and contextualization in the lesson for effective teaching and learning
