UPSKILLING OF SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS ON THE INDIVIDUAL CATEGORIES OF **CAMPUS JOURNALISM**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. Pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 7079, also known as Campus Journalism Act of 1991, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (1RR) specifically Rule IX of Section I, the Department of Education Regional Office IX, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division announces the conduct of the Upskilling of School Paper Advisers on the Individual Categories of the NSPC on August 27-28, 2023, at NEAP R Airport, Tiguma, Pagadian City.
- 2. The objective of this activity is to empower the SPAs with comprehensive expertise in news, sports, editorial, science and technology, feature writing, copy reading and headline writing, column, photojournalism, and editorial cartooning categories, enabling them to effectively guide and mentor student journalists. This upskilling aims to enhance advisers' competence, improve student performance, ensure adherence to journalistic standards, foster creativity, and promote ethical journalism practices, ultimately enhancing the overall quality of student entries and facilitating a more successful participation in the National Schools Press Conference (NSPC).
- 3. The target participants are the school paper advisers in the elementary and secondary levels both private and public schools. They shall register at https://bit.ly/upskillSPA2023 on or before August 25, 2023.
- 4. The training shall start on August 27, 2023, at 8:00 a.m.
