Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC) with the theme: "Charity Truth: Journalism as a Catalyst for positive change in the Media Landscape of 2024" to be conducted on February 23-24, 2024 and to be hosted by Liloy I district, Liloy NHS, Compra NHS and Patawag NHS, poblacion Liloy, Zamboanga del Norte.

- provide learners opportunities to use the skills learned in campus journalism e. for their future careers.

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- 5. All schools in the concerned districts that are planning to participate in the school, district, cluster and division level press conference should ensure that their school paper publications contain at least 12-page PDF or digital format which shall have the following sections: news, editorial, feature, science & technology and sports. NO campus journalist shall be accepted for the individual competition without the COMPLETE sections of the paper. The school publication shall be from the school year 2023-2024. Previous publications in print and PDF shall NOT be eligible as tickets to the competitions. In the editorial board NOT editorial staff, always include the school principal.
- 6. For those schools participating in the group category, encourage your school paper advisers to come up with a minimum of 12 or 16-20 pages. ONLY TWO school paper advisers are allowed to run the paper and are allowed to join from the school, district, cluster, division or higher level competitions. One is the OFFICIAL publication adviser, the other one co-adviser.
- 7. All stand-alone Senior High Schools shall compete separately across categories. Integrated schools may join in two levels for both the elementary and secondary. Combi schools or schools with Junior and Senior High Schools shall compose one team only.
- 8. The DSPC activities shall include the following:

- ii. Features Writing
- iii. Editorial Writing
- iv. Sports Writing
- v. Copyreading and Headline Writing
- vi. Science and Technology Writing
- vii. Photojournalism

- ix. Column Writing

b. Group Contest

- Radio Script Writing and Broadcasting (English and Filipino, elementary & secondary)
- ii. Collaborative Desktop Publishing (English and Filipino, elementary and secondary)
- iii. Online Publishing (English and Filipino, secondary only)
- iv. TV Script Writing and Broadcasting (English and Filipino, secondary

c. School Paper Contest (English and Filipino, elementary and secondary, in Portable Document Format)

- i. News Section
- ii. Features Section
- iii. Editorial Section
- iv. Science and Technology Section
- v. Sports Section
- vi. Layout and Page Design







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d. Awarding of Outstanding School Paper Advisers (SPAs) and Campus Journalists (CJs)

- 9. Recognizing and respecting Intellectual Property Rights, the Department adheres to the rules concerning plagiarism. DepEd reiterates its stand to disqualify school papers found to have copied and published texts, graphics, and other materials without duly acknowledging their sources. The disqualification covers all sections of the school paper. All winning school papers in the 2024 DSPC shall attach their respective Turnitin Results for the 2024 RSPC.
- 10. Any form of plagiarism in all competitions as proven by the board of judges shall be grounds for disqualification.
- 11. The decision of the Board of Judges is FINAL and IRREVOCABLE.

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- 13. A campus journalist can participate in only one event, either individual or group category.
- 14. The top seven (7) winners in all individual categories, the CHAMPION for the group categories and the top 15 for school paper shall be recognized. Only the accumulated points from individual and group contests shall be included in the computation of the overall scores.
- 15. The delegations shall wear any t-shirt in any color to identify their school or district.
- 16. All participants in the individual categories shall wear their respective school uniforms during the contest proper, while collaborative desktop publishing, online publishing, and radio scriptwriting and broadcasting shall wear white shirts. Meanwhile, TV Broadcasting participants should wear their appropriate attire.
- 17. Each region is expected to submit the required documents using the format provided in the following enclosures:

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- Learners of the elementary (Grades 4-6) and secondary levels (both junior and senior high schools) are eligible to join the contests.
- Participants, coaches, SPAs, and working committees shall bring their water 19. tumblers, extension wires, and sleeping gears. They shall take charge of their meals and snacks during the duration of the activity.
- For Radio and TV Script Writing and Broadcasting contestants, an orientation will be conducted on March 12, 2024 at 5:00pm - 6:00pm. Details of the venue will be relayed through the Division Supervisor in charge of Campus Journalism a week prior to the conduct of the orientation.
- Teaching personnel including school paper advisers, coaches, officers, members of the TWG, and working committees who are involved in the actual conduct of the 2024 RSPC shall be given one-day service credit. Meanwhile, non-teaching personnel shall be given a one-day compensatory time off (CTO).
- All school paper advisers and TWG members shall be granted with maximum of two-day service credits and/or Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) in lieu of the workshop days that will fall on weekends for the completion of their respective school publications for the 2024 DSPC in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2023, Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers, and CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2015, Policies and Guidelines on Overtime Services and Overtime Pay for Government Employees, respectively.
- The participants, school paper advisers, coaches, and officials' traveling, board, and 23. lodging expenses shall be charged against school/division MOOE and/or local funds, subject to the usual accounting, budgeting, and auditing rules and regulations. Private schools may have their own options. NO REGISTRATION or any FEE shall be collected from the participants in the DIVISION level.
