> ADMINISTRATION OF THE COMPUTER-BASED DIVISION ACHIEVEMENT TEST FOR 2<sup>nd</sup> QUARTER AND DIAGNOSTIC TEST FOR 3<sup>RD</sup> QUARTER, SY 2022-2023

To: **Public Schools District Supervisors** Concerned Principals/SHs, Public Elementary & Secondary Schools Division/District/School IT Coordinators Division/District/School Testing Coordinators All Others Concerned

- Consistent with the MATATAG agenda along improved delivery of education services, as well as the Division Reform Agenda, re: Giving Teachers Support To Teach Better, the Schools Division of Zamboanga del Norte announces the administration of the Computerbased Division Achievement Test (3rd Quarter) and Diagnostic Test (4th Quarter) of this SY, on April 26 & 29, 2024.
- 2. The objectives of these tests are the following: a. to provide feedback about the learning and teaching process; b. to gather relevant information about learner's performance or progress; and c. to determine learners' interests to make judgments about the learning approaches and pedagogies.
- The test shall be administered to all sampled learners of all grade levels in the identified schools across the division. For the elementary, all Central Schools, one (1) Noncentral School, and one (1) Multigrade school per district shall be tested. For Multigrade, only Grades 3 and 6 learners shall be tested from the combination classes. All main secondary schools and one (1) small school per district shall be tested in the secondary.

In case a sample school for e\_DAT and e-DDT is likewise sampled for the Regional Achievement Test (RAT) 2024 - which will be administered on April 29-May 3, 2024, said school shall participate the RAT, and shall be replaced by another school for the e DAT and e-DDT.

- Attached, please find the list of identified participating schools in each of the 35 districts, as well as the Administrative Clauses, for information and guidance of all.
- The school testing coordinators with the assistance of the school or district IT coordinators shall be the key testing personnel to serve as test administration and IT support staff, respectively (. The District Testing Coordinator, with the concurrence of the

## LOCAL CB-DAT & DDT 2024 ADMINISTRATIVE CLAUSES

Consistent with the applicable provisions of DepEd Order No. 55, s. 2016; re: Policy Guidelines on the National Assessment of Student Learning for the K to 12 Education Program, provisions specific in the e-DAT & e-DDT Handbook, and other governing issuances, the following stipulations and terms of reference are hereby set forth, for reference of all concerned, to wit:

- 1. **Preparation of Testing Room/s.** The host school/testing center is directed to prepare the testing room/s such that the computer sets be re-arranged to observe at least one (1) meter distance between examinees. The school is likewise expected to set up holding area/room(s) for waiting examinees, isolation area in case an examinee/s is/are found to have experienced flu, fever and other symptoms of diseases.
- 2. Computer Units and the Alternatives. Ideally, the computer laboratory with at least 30 functional computers, if any, shall be an ideal testing room. Ten computer units to be used are those that pass the technical requirements for this test as may be set forth by the IT expert or the one preparing the test software. In the event the desk top computer units are not available, laptops and even cellphones may be used as alternative devices to access the test materials.
- 3. Provision of ICT Equipment and Tools. In view of the necessity to have stable internet connection to each of the computer units or laptops to be used during the test, the school head of the host school, in close coordination with the host PSDS, and the district/school ICT Coordinators are enjoined to facilitate the borrowing of modems from nearby schools or districts for the aforesaid purpose. Expenses incurred by the borrower/ee school for the pre-paid internet load may be reimbursed using the division funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations;
- 4. Reminders To The Examinees. Each learner- examinee is expected to be in his/her assigned testing center at least one (1) hour before scheduled time of test. An examinee who comes late by at least fifteen (15) minutes shall be replaced by a buffer examinee. Aside from bringing and wearing health and safety goggle, he/she is expected to bring valid identification ID card, snacks/lunch. Cellphones, wrist watch and other gadgets which may be used to break the integrity of test material.
- 5. Non-suspension of other classes. Classes in un-affected grade levels shall continue during these 2-day tests. The school principal is however given the discretion to give the sampled examinees certain period of rest after they are done taking the test. In no case shall the rest period be longer than a day.
- 6. Delegated Responsibilities. The following field personnel are delegated with responsibilities, relative to the smooth and orderly test administration, to wit:

- 7. Contingency In case of Brown Out. Since the test administration is dependent of electricity, contingency over the possibility of power interruption should have been prepared. To this effect, the host school is enjoined to provide stand-by generator, and its consumables thru outsourcing, rental and/or procurement using school local funds, whenever applicable, subject to the availability of funds;
- 8. Provision of Food and Materials. The host school is enjoined to cover against their local school funds the provisions of food for the testing personnel, medical personnel and DTC-TWG members as well as those who may be tapped by the school head to augment the workforce of the division office, as well as the common office supplies and office consumables which may be utilized during the test conduct, subject to the availability of funds and to the usual COA auditing and accounting rules and regulations;
- 9. Pre- DAT & DDT Preparations. The DTC-TWG, in coordination with the Division ICT and his select ICT field counterparts Are encouraged to conduct ocular inspection from February 8-14, 2024, to each testing center to ensure readiness of the computer sets, and the rooms to be used during the test, and to coordinate with office concerns, including but not limited to the school heads, barangay council, and/or municipal health unit, to cover the contingencies that may arise during the test administration.
- 10. Service Credits/Compensatory Time-Off. Per Joint CSC-DBM Circular No. 2, s. 2004, service credits or the Compensatory Overtime Credit, as the case may be, shall be given to the concerned division and field personnel who may have rendered services during a holiday, weekend, or beyond the official time pursuant to the preparatory and post-administration activities of e-DAT and e-DDT. To this effect, the concerned school head, or the designated district testing coordinator is authorized to sign, in behalf of the division testing coordinator, in the DTR of the requesting personnel.
