Subject: **MANDATING THE IDENTIFIED UNDERLOADED REGULAR ALIVE TEACHERS TO EXTEND TEACHING SERVICES TO NEARBY SCHOOL/S NEEDING ALIVE PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION**

Date: May 16, 2016

1. Pursuant to the objective of mainstreaming and institutionalizing Madrasah Education as a component of the National System of Basic Education to Muslim children in the Public through ALIVE Program, the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) under the Rationalization Program has the task of providing the appropriate and relevant educational opportunities by ensuring the full implementation of the cultural-sensitive program.
2. As mandated in the DepEd Order No.77, series 2010 and DepEd Order No. 30, series 2012, Madrasah Teacher Item is identified as an allotted regular plantilla item under the special group granted to Asatidz who are hired and deployed in the schools having a minimum of fifteen (15) Muslim Learners.
3. In addition, as stipulated in the DepEd Order No. 28, series of 2015 (under section 3.2.3), those Asatidz who were given the Madrasah Item must handle or give more priority on the ALIVE Subjects. They are only allowed to have an additional K to 12 subjects if necessary. They are also allowed to receive the benefits and incentives enjoyed by other Teachers (including School MOOE and others).
4. As observed in the 13 ALIVE Implementing districts, especially in the 3rd Congressional District, some schools mostly dominated by Muslim Learners are not enjoying the ALIVE Program because of the scarcity of Madrasah Items in the division.
5. In view hereof, Regular ALIVE Teachers handling less than the required compulsory service in their organized ALIVE Classes are mandated to extend their teaching services to Muslim children in the nearby school/s qualified for the ALIVE Program implementation in their district to complete their required 360 minutes regular teaching load per day.

6. Report in compliance to this Memorandum is expected to be submitted to this office by the School Heads of the identified schools (*see attached format*)
7. To ensure successful implementation of the ALIVE Program, a regular monthly monitoring activity shall be undertaken by the Division ALIVE Coordinator, Public Schools District Supervisor, School Heads, District ALIVE Coordinators of the 13 MEP Implementing Districts.
8. Widest and immediate dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is hereby desired.


