1. DepEd is anchored on the Global Commitment on Education for all children to provide access to quality education, where all children are right-holders and must be given the opportunity to learn, irrespective of race, color, religion or culture. Thus, Madrasah Education was developed through *DepEd Order No. 51, series of 2004*, it is a mechanism of teaching the unreached and providing education that is meaningful, relevant and culture-sensitive for Muslim Children. It is also a vital component of the National Educational System where mainstreaming the two (2) subjects; Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education (ALIVE) in all public schools operating nationwide.

In order to recognize the academic performance of the ALIVE pupils in these two (2) subjects and giving them the chance to show their skills and talents, the Division Office will conduct the **2ND DIVISION ALIVE MUSABAQA (SKILLS EXHIBITION) 2016** on October 21, 2016, with the following purposes stated under:

- a. provide the ALIVE learners with appropriate and relevant opportunities through competition;
 - b. showcase various products and performances as evidence of the pupils learning;
 - c. strengthen and upgrade the pupils level of competence in facing life's challenges;
 - d. reinforce support of administrators, key officials, parents and communities to the Madrasah Education Program (MEP).
2. In prior to the said activity, SCHOOL ALIVE MUSABAQA shall be done on October 13, 2016, DISTRICT ALIVE MUSABAQA on October 14, 2016 and Cluster-Districts MUSABAQA on October 18, 2016, adopting the Mechanics of the eight (8) categories of the DIVISION ALIVE MUSABAQA attached to this memorandum.

The Cluster-Districts are identified as follows:

Dinner as first meal will be served on October 20, 2016 at JKC and Re-Orientation of Division MUSABAQA Mechanics for Category Officials, Judges and Coaches will be conducted after dinner at 7:30 PM on October 20, 2016.**

5. Identified Working Committees are advised to report at the venue on October 20, 2016 at 9:00 AM for the Pre-Planning Activity and stage decoration.
6. Each winner should bring documents duly signed by the District ALIVE Coordinator and Public Schools District Supervisor certifying that their contestants are officially enrolled for SY 2016-2017 (*see attached MUSABAQA Entry Form*).
7. Coaches shall submit the official list and MUSABAQA Entry Form of their respective delegation to the Chairman of each MUSABAQA Category on October 20, 2015.
8. Expenses incurred such as boarding and lodging, prizes, supplies and materials, transportation, foods, accommodation and honorarium (Judges) of the Division ALIVE Coordinator and regular teachers, and other supplemental expenses shall be charged against Division Program Support Fund (PSF) while travelling, and other related expenses of coaches and contestants shall be charged to School MOOE/Local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
