

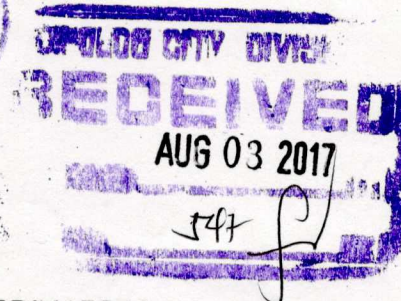

SUBJECT : **6th ASEAN SCOUT JAMBOREE**

1. The ASEAN Scout Association for Regional Cooperation, through the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP), will host the **6th ASEAN Scout Jamboree** with the theme **Growth and Stability** from November 27 to December 2, 2017 at the Energy Park, Apokon, Tagum City, Davao del Norte.
2. The Jamboree aims to provide a progressive, safe and enjoyable learning environment for the Scouts in order to enhance their physical, social, mental, emotional and spiritual potentials. At the end of the Jamboree, the participants should be able to:
 - a. promote ASEAN Community and Solidarity;
 - b. promote the highest quality of Scouting, one that is faithful to the mission, principles and method of Scouting and adapted to the needs and aspirations of young people;
 - c. undertake high adventure activities, including community service projects related to the current thrust of World Scouting (Environment Education, Peace Education and Development Education) through the different World Programmes under the Better World Framework-Messengers of the Peace (MoP) Initiatives, World Scout Environment Programme (WSEP) and its ancillary programs (Scouts Go Solar, YUNGA, Challenge Badges), and the Scouts of the World (SW) Award Program;
 - d. undergo projects, programs and activities which will cater to the fulfillment of the requirements of selected merit badges and scout ranks under the Advancement Scheme;
 - e. develop core life skills and 21st century leadership capabilities through team building, cooperative learning, group dynamics, creative problem-solving and decision-making skills; and
 - f. keep oneself abreast with the prevailing issues about the environment, human rights, health, education, culture and science and technology through the Global Development Village, City of Science and Cross Road of Cultures, among others.
3. The following are the qualifications for participation to the 6th ASEAN Scout Jamboree:
 - 3.1 **Scouts** is expected to have leadership potentials, sufficient camping experience, physically fit to undergo strenuous activities and parents approval and must be:
 - Must be currently registered with the BSP
 - 10 years old but not over 17½ years old
 - Equipped with camping gears

- 3.2 **Adult Leader** must have maturity and clarity about his role and must be:
- Currently registered with the BSP
 - Trained as an Adult Leader and have served as Unit Leaders for at least two (2) years
 - Physically Fit as certified by a physician
 - Equipped with camping gears
 - and in Good Moral Character

3.3 **Registration:**

A delegation fee of **FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (Php 4, 500.00)** shall be charged to each participant to defray expenses:

- Jamboree Registration Fee	Php	500.00
- Meals & Snacks x 7 days		1, 400.00
- Transportation Fare (Dipolog City- Cagayan de Oro-Davao-Tagum) & back		2, 600.00

	Php	4, 500.00

The registration fee, transportation and other incidental expenses are chargeable against local funds or local school board funds or solicited from other agencies subject to auditing rules and regulations.

The scouts and adults leaders are encouraged to bring their own utensils (plate, pork and spoon, glass, and others).

Like in any other camping, scouts and Unit Leaders are required to provide their own camping equipment.

Pre – jamboree is schedule November 18 - 19, 2017, at the BSP Office, Gen. Luna St., corner Sorronda Avenue, Dipolog City.

4. It is expected that Districts, Secondary/Elementary and Private Secondary/Elementary Schools of Zamboanga del Norte Province, Dipolog City, and Dapitan City shall organize their contingent. Efforts should be vigorously exerted to promote maximum participation in this activity.




