

Relative to the Memorandum No. 76 s.2017 dated 1 June 2017 from the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council, the conduct of the 2nd Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED) will take place on June 29, 2017, 2:00 PM at UM Bolton Campus, Bolton St., Davao City. The drill will test the contingency plans of government agencies for an earthquake with the impact of a 7.2 magnitude in the National Capital Region (NCR), Region III and Region IV-A. With this, all schools and DepEd offices are directed to conduct Earthquake Drills simultaneously.

Herewith is the list of things'to do in preparation for the earthquake drill:

- · Connect with the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (LDRRMC) for an orientation on carthquake to understand intensity and possible impacts. Discuss preparedness measures.
- Map out personnel/ learners and contact numbers.
- · Determine communication flow among offices/ schools and overall
- · Determine personnel/ learners with special needs in case of an earthquake; assign focal persons within the particular office/ classroom to take charge of those personnel/ learners with special
