Hereunder is the initial information about the event.

PARTICIPANTS : A patrol of Junior/ Senior/Cadet Girl Scouts or more with Adult Leaders.
 No limit as to number of campers. Districts and Schools may send as many patrols provided they are qualified.

FEE : P460.00 per camper (Girl & Adult) to cover the program materials, camp souvenirs and Insurance Fee.

QUALIFICATION OF PARTICIPANTS

GIRL:

9. Currently registered Junior / Senior / Cadet Girl Scout.
10. Must be physically fit and alert.
11. Must have earned at least one badge under the 8-Point Challenge.
12. Must have attended a troop / patrol camp prior to this encampment.

ADULT:

7. Currently registered Troop Leader.
8. Preferably a Campcraft Certificate Holder.
9. Must be physically and mentally fit.

Costume for the presentation by sub-camp	Extra shirts for obstacle games
Official black shoes	Bedroll or sleeping bag
Sleeping garments (blanket or malong)	Girl scout knife
Insect repellant	Raincoat/ Slipper and rubber shoes
PATROL EQUIPMENT	
Cooking facilities (stove, pots, pans, utensils, etc.)	Materials for camp gadgets
Food services (platters, bowls, serving items, water jug or pitchers)	Bulletin (made of cloth, safety pins to tuck on notices, etc.)
Washing facilities (pails, basins, detergent, and dish towels)	Quarter tent, fly tent for kitchen shed, and plastic bags for waste disposal Delegates must make their latrine.
Each patrol will bring their own food provisions in camp	Rechargeable lamp

Camera/ Musical Instrument	Souvenirs/Tokens for exchange with other campers
MATERIALS FOR ACTIVITY	
Extra Costumes for District/School Presentations (Talent Shows & other costumes) based on the tentative program of activities, sewing kit, coloring materials and recycling materials such as used papers.	


District commissioners/School commissioners are encouraged to send participants for the said encampment.

RE : ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR THE 29th Council Wide Camp

DATE : 26 October 2017

Herewith are additional information regarding the upcoming 29th Council Wide Camp on November 25-29, 2017 at Liloy Central School, Fatima, Liloy, Zamboanga del Norte with the theme: "Today's Girls, Tomorrow's Leaders".

You will note that the term "encampment" has been changed to "camp" as per National Executive Decision No. 2017-339 and confirmed by the Central Board at its meeting on August 5, 2017.

1. To give ample time for the Council to prepare the souvenirs and encampment materials, please confirm the number of participants on or before November 15, 2017.
2. All vehicles of the campers are not allowed to park inside the camp, except on the arrival and departure dates. Drivers are also advised not to stay inside the camp for the whole duration. It will be strictly implemented by the detailed PNP Personnel.
3. Troop Leaders are advised to submit list of campers in duplicate with the Application forms, Health Examination Form and Parents Consent upon registration.
4. All delegates are advised to make their own latrines only. The campsite has available comfort rooms and bathrooms for the campers.
5. Campers must bring their own old T-shirt preferably white color for the arts and craft "TIE and DYE" activity.
6. There will be a Twinklers Playday and Star Holiday on November 26, 2017. A one (1) day outdoor activities for the Twinklers and Stars to let them experience the outdoor fun and adventure.
 - a. There will be a registration fee of Php 150.00 per Twinkler/Stars to include the ID and souvenir item for the Twinklers and Star Scouts.


- a. Twinklers and Star Scouts are also invited to during the opening ceremony on November 25, 2017 and they are advised to wear their "Disney Attire"
- b. Parents Consent must be secured.
- c. All districts are encouraged to bring at least 1 patrol of Twinklers and Star Scouts.

13. To maximize the attendance of the Adult Leaders/Chaperon, there will be a Council Troop Leaders Forum on November 27, 2017. This forum will have GSP updates and outdoor activities for all the troop leaders.



The breakdown for the Camp Registration Fee amounting for Php 460.00 will be Php 400.00 Camp Fee and 60.00 Camp Insurance Fee (as per National Executive Committee, it was approved at its meeting on Nov. 4, 2016 that in all National, Regional and Council encampments, an insurance coverage must be secured for all campers, Troop Leaders and camp staff to include accidents, disablement, dismemberment and accidental death that will be included in the event/camp registration fee). The camp insurance fee will be facilitated by the Philippine Redcross, Campers who are currently registered in Redcross will not anymore pay the Camp Insurance Fee provided the troop leaders must present the Redcross ID and Registration Form of the campers upon registration. Campers are entitled for one year coverage of the insurance fee from the date of registration.
