The Girl Scouts of the Philippines will once again hold its 40th **GSP National Camp** to be hosted by the Visayas Region will be held on November 30 to December 5, 2017 at the Marina Yulo Vargas Regional Program and Training Center (MYV RPTC), Capitol Hills, Cebu City. The theme is "Paggiya, Pagkinabuhi, Pag-alagad" (Lead, Live, Serve).

<u>PARTICIPANTS</u>: 2 patrols (16 Senior/Cadet Girl Scouts) per Council

CAMP FEE: P4,000.00 (Four Thouşand Pesos) per camper inclusive of food provision during the duration of the camp, program materials, camp souvenirs, group insurance, and transportation during offsite activities.

QUALIFICATIONS OF PARTICIPANTS

- 1. Must be a registered Senior/Cadet Girl Scout as of December 2017.
- 2. Must be physically fit and alert.
- 3. Must have earned at least one badge each under the 8-Point Challenge.
- 4. Must have attended a troop/patrol/council/regional camp prior to this encampment.
- 5. Must be a Patrol Leader's Camp Permit Course Certificate Holder or has attended the Patrol Leader's Camp Permit Course.

ARRIVAL IN CAMP

The campers are expected to arrive in camp on Thursday, November 30. Campers who will arrive before November 30, will be accommodated at the MYV RPTC at Php 50.00/day for the use of camp grounds and will prepare their own meals.

CHAPERONS

All official chaperones of the campers must be Senior/Cadet Troop Leaders. They are required to attend the National Troop Leaders' Forum to maximize their time during the encampment. The registration fee and venue will be announced in a separate circular.

All interested Senior/Cadet Girl Scouts must send their application forms on or before November 15, 2017 for Council Screening. Participants will be given proper orientation/pre training by the council for the said National Camp.

The Zamboanga del Norte Girl Scout Council will shoulder half of the registration fee amounting to Php 2,000.00 per participants.
