**COUNCIL OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2012 entitled "Revitalizing Boy Scouting in Schools" which intends to develop boys and young men into well-rounded individuals with exemplary character worth the emulation of school children, this Division will conduct a live-in **BSP Crew Leadership Training Course (CLTC)** and **Patrol Leadership Training Course (PLTC)** to the following:

20 – 22 October 2017                      Kalawit National High School  
Kalawit District

23 – 25 October 2017                      Sindangan National Agricultural School  
Sindangan National High School

2. The training course aims to:

- a. demonstrate typical Boy/Senior Scouting activities and the need for intelligent coordination of effort through leadership;
- b. make the participants understand the necessity for discipline and good order;
- c. demonstrate the technique of "learning through doing" by immediate application of Scouting Skills; and
- d. direct the Patrol/Crew Leaders' attention towards the opportunities for leadership in Scouting.

3. The participants to this training are currently registered Senior Scouts from the Boy Scouts of the Philippines preferably in **Grade 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10.**

4. The **training fee of P150.00/participant** to cover the training materials, handouts, certificate and other administrative expenses shall be charged to MOOE/Local Funds.

5. Participants shall report to the training venue in the afternoon of the first day of the training and they are advised to bring the following:

- a. Type A and B uniform (Type A uniform is optional)
- b. BSP Senior Scout neckerchief and carabao slide
- c. Clothes for three (3) days
- d. Writing materials
- e. Meals and snacks (good for three (3) days)
- f. Dome tent with sleeping gears
- g. Toiletries and personal belongings
- h. Food and drinking water for two days
- i. Individual Cooking Pot and Firewood for breakfast activity (Compulsory)
- j. Kitchen and cooking utensils **per patrol/crew**
- k. Scout knife
