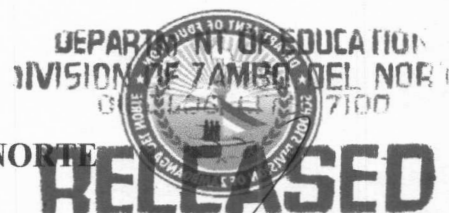




1. With the desire to address the gap on the different issues, concerns and challenges that hinder the successful implementation of Araling Panlipunan Curriculum , a Division Consultative Workshop on the Critical Content in Araling Panlipunan will be conducted on February 8, 2017 at Mibang Hotel, Dipolog City.
2. The objectives of this activity are the following:
 - a. identify the critical content based on the least mastered competencies;
 - b. determine relevant issues affecting the curriculum implementation;
 - c. suggest ways on how to address the critical issues and content affecting the curriculum implementation;
 - d. create plans to systematically address the needs of the respective schools/districts.
3. The participants of this workshop are the teachers teaching Araling Panlipunan in Junior high school. The one hundred nine(109) secondary schools ^{schools} will send one (1) AP teacher. There will be a total of 109 participants.
4. The participants are advised to bring laptop and agree with other teacher participants within the cluster congressional district to bring printer for the reproduction of outputs. They should coordinate with their respective school heads.

6. Travelling and incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against school MOOE subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
