2018-2019 LINE-UP OF ACTIVITIES IN ENGLISH FOR IMPLEMENTATION

A. TRACKING OF LEARNERS' PERFROMANCE THROUGH THE INTERVENTIONS IN THE ITEM ANALYSIS

In here, all the grade level teachers in English are requested to forward the item analysis with interventions of the least-mastered competencies to the next grade level teacher, so that the planned interventions will be followed up. (Example: Grade I fourth quarter item analysis will be forwarded to the Grade II teacher, Grade II teacher will forward the fourth quarter item analysis of the previous school year to the Grade III teacher and so on until Grade 10.

Reasons:

- To track students' performance by giving life or by implementing the suggested interventions of the least-mastered competencies in the fourth quarterly examination of the previous school year in every grade level; the grade 5 item analysis will be forwarded to the grade 6 teachers.
- Likewise, same process is to be done in the junior high school. The grade 7 English teachers will forward their fourth quarter item analysis to the grade 8 English teachers, grade 8 item analysis to grade 9 and grade 9 to grade 10. This ends here.
- All the receiving teachers of this years' students in all grade levels are directed to focus
 on the least-mastered competencies of each pupil. For the suggested interventions,
 teachers may follow them or may modify them depending on the specific demand of
 each child/student.
- All the interventions made by the teachers in the item analysis will now serve as their TOOL in tracking students' performance. These are not just for display in the reading corners. This is an important tool for the EPS (English), PSDSs, School Heads and English teachers.
- The act of forwarding the item analysis with intervention is for the next grade level teacher to discover the weakest points of the learners and as they move to the next grade level the same competencies will be taught to them as stipulated in the curriculum guides, these are getting more complicated or leveled up because these competencies are spiraled.
- In the item analysis, computation of correct responses is NOT enough. There is a need
 to think about what they can do to the LEAST-MASTERED COMPETENCIES to
 improve students' performance. That is why, teachers need to look back to the tested
 competencies embodied in the TOS in the quarterly examinations they conducted.
 There and then they can decide for the necessary interventions.
- Remember, displaying figures such as MPS or MASTERY LEVEL IS MEANINGLESS... unless given meaning through necessary interventions addressed to our learners who are wanting for love and attention. So, as 21st century teachers, what we need is just a little LOVE for them to become 21st century learners....in order to STOP the CYCLE of UNDER ACHIEVEMENT and START the CYCLE OF SUCCESS.
