

SUBJECT: **ORIENTATION ON THE GUIDELINES FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE JOINT DELIVERY VOUCHER PROGRAM (JDVP) FOR SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (SHS) TECHNICAL VOCATIONAL LIVELIHOOD (TVL) SPECIALIZATIONS FOR SY 2017-2018**

1. In reference to DepEd Order No. 67, s. 2017, re: *Guidelines on the Implementation of the Joint Delivery Voucher Program (JDVP) for Senior High School (SHS) Technical Vocational Livelihood (TVL) Specializations for 2017-2018*, and as per advisory from the higher authority, this Office hereby directs the conduct of Orientation on the subject on **January 27, 2018, 8:00 AM-5:00 PM**, at **Mibang Hotel**, Sta, Felomina, Dipolog City.
2. The objectives of the one-day orientation are as follows:
 - i. *make the participants understand the Joint Delivery Voucher Program for SHS Technical Vocational Livelihood Specializations for SY 2017-2018, as well as the processes involved in its implementation; and*
 - ii. *strengthen collaborative efforts of all SHS implementing schools, by coming up with platforms to observe or to agree on for the effective and efficient implementation of the JDVL-TVL program in this Division.*
3. Participants of the said orientation are the school principals of the *sixty-five (65) public SHS Implementing Schools, and the School Heads/ Administrators from fifteen (15) Non-DEPED Senior High Implementing Schools* offering TVL Track, in this Division.
4. Each participant from the Non-DepEd Schools shall be charged registration fee of **Php 500.00**, to cover the expenses for food, and the cost for the certificates.

5. Participants from the public SHS implementing schools shall be entitled for a Compensatory Time-Off Certificates, since the schedule of the orientation falls on a Saturday. Travel expenses which may be incurred by the public school participants shall be charged against their respective School MOOE, subject to the usual auditing and accounting rules and regulations. While, travel expenses of those from private/no-DepEd schools are borne by their respective school funds, subject to their own internal auditing and accounting norms.
