In support to the DepEd Ten-Point Agenda 2017-2022 entitled Quality, Accessible, Relevant and Liberating Basic Education for All and to strengthen the DepEd's Every Child A Reader Program, making every Filipino Child a competent reader and writer appropriate for his/her grade level, this office announces the conduct of the **Orientation and Training on the Implementation of School-Based Tutorial for Struggling/Frustration Readers on May 29 – 30, 2019.
