**Subject:** 9<sup>th</sup> ASEAN QUIZ DIVISION LEVEL

**Date:** November 20, 2019

1. This has reference to DepEd Memorandum No. 163 s. 2019 dated November 4, 2019 entitled 9<sup>th</sup> ASEAN QUIZ by which the National Level Competition will be conducted by the People's Television Network (PTN), in partnership with the Department of Education (DepEd), the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA), the Presidential Communication Operations Office (PCOO), the Philippine Information Agency (PIA), and the Philippine Broadcasting Service (PBS) from January 20-23, 2020 at the PTV Broadcasting Center, Visayas Avenue, Quezon City.
2. In view of this, the Schools Division of Zamboanga del Norte will conduct the division level competition on November 25, 2019 which shall commence at 10:00 o'clock in the morning at the Division Conference Room, Capitol Drive, Estaka, Dipolog City.
3. Each cluster shall send one (1) contestant who is the CHAMPION of the cluster level competition. Hence, only five (5) participants will compete for the division level. The Division Champion will represent the Regional level competition to be conducted on December 10, 2019 at the LRMSD building, DepEd Regional Office IX, Airport Road, Tiguma, Pagadian City.
4. The student-participants should meet the following requirements based on the 9<sup>th</sup> ASEAN Quiz National Competition Implementation Guidelines:
  - a. Must be in Grade 9 or 10, between fifteen (15) to seventeen (17) years old; must not be 18 years old by the time of the National Competition which will be held in the first quarter of 2020;
  - b. Must come from either a public or a private school;
  - c. Must be proficient in English language, both oral and written;
  - d. Must have a grade of 85 and above in Social Studies during the first quarter of the School Year 2019-2020;
  - e. Must have good interpersonal skills/good team player;
  - f. Must be physically fit;
  - g. Must be willing (with parental consent) to travel to Dipolog City and to the place of venues for the higher level competition if given the fortune to win; and
  - h. Must meet other criteria that may deem necessary by the ASEAN Quiz Organizing Committee.
5. Top three winning contestants in the Division level competition shall receive trophies and medals while certificate of recognition shall be awarded to the winning coaches.
6. Travel allowances and expenses incurred by the participants relative to their attendance to this activity and to the higher level competition shall be chargeable against School MOOE/Local Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
