Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2012 entitled "Revitalizing Boy Scouting in Schools" which intends to develop boys and young men into well-rounded individuals with exemplary character worth the emulation of school children, this Division inviting the registered scout both Senior and Boys Scouts to participate the 2019 CHRISTMAS ADVANCEMENT CAMP on December 26 -29, 2019 at the BSP Scouts Camp, Brgy. Compra, Liloy, Zamboanga del Norte.

- 2. The advancement camp aims to:
  - a. Direct the Scout's attention towards the opportunities in Advancement scheme of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines.

- 5. The Advancement Camp Fee of P 300.00/participant to cover 3 ½ days food supplies, training materials, certificate, and other administrative expenses.
- 6. Participants shall report to the training venue on December 26, 2019 (Thursday) at 1:00 PM. They are advised to bring the following:
  - Type A and B uniform
  - b. BSP Boy/Senior Scout neckerchief and carabao slide
  - Clothes for three (4) days
  - d. Writing materials
  - Camping tent with sleeping gears
  - Toiletries and personal belongings f.
  - Water container
  - Kitchen and cooking utensils per Patrol/Crew
  - Bolo/Scout knife
