

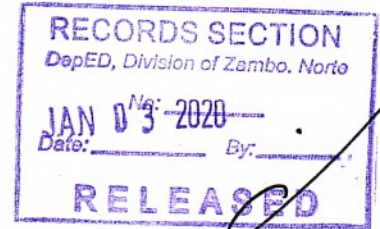

Subject: Division ALS Academic Contest Cum Performance Review and Awarding of Exemplary ALS Implementers

Date: January 2, 2020

1. This division has released division memorandum entitled **ALS Academic Contest Cum Year End Performance Review** dated November 11, 2019 which was supposedly to be conducted on December 10, 2019 which was cancelled due to overlapping of activities, however, the activity will be moved to January 16, 2020 at Bayangan Hotel and Beach Resort.
2. For the ALS Quiz Bee in A & E Elementary and Secondary, the winning coach shall submit to the quiz masters in-charge during the day of the contest five questions for easy and average level with multiple choices and five questions for difficult level with no options and 5 clincher questions. ALS Modules shall be the sole basis for the questions of the A & E (Elementary) while SUGPAT Modules for the A & E (Secondary). Contestants are required to bring their own Show Me Board and Chalk/Marker. For the poster making contest, it is reiterated that the theme will be Family is Love to depict the importance of love in the family. The winning entry per cluster shall be responsible in bringing the illustration board, pastel and other materials to be used in the contest. Attached is the in-charge of the different contests and committees.
3. The performance review of each cluster, instead of a ten-minute video presentation each cluster shall prepare only a five-minute presentation which will highlight the best practices and accomplishments for the year 2019.
4. After the performance review, awarding of exemplary ALS implementers will follow. Awards to be given to the implementers and other DepEd personalities shall be based on the following merits and considerations, to wit:
  - a. Top 3 DALSCs with highest number of passers per cluster
  - b. Top 3 Mobile Teachers with highest number of passers per cluster
  - c. Implementers who have organized a functional locally initiated livelihood training program to the learners

- d. Implementers who through their efforts and linkages with various agencies (TESDA, DTI, etc.) have organized livelihood training programs to the learners
  - e. Implementers who have implemented the Special Education Program (SPED) in ALS
  - f. Implementers serving four barangays and above
  - g. Implementers serving the farthest barangay in each district
  - h. School/Principal implementing Balik Paaralan-Out of School Adults (BP-OSA)
  - i. District/Implementers conducting District ALS Festival
  - j. Implementers with highest number of learners joining the First Cluster-Wide Neighborhood Scouting per cluster
  - k. Implementers in the District/PSDS with highest combined number of learners in the district joining the First Cluster-Wide Neighborhood Scouting per cluster
  - l. Cluster/EPISA having the biggest number of delegation during the First Cluster-Wide Neighborhood Scouting
  - m. Implementers through their efforts and support have sent learner/s to the One-Mindanao Scout Jamboree
5. All EPSAs are advised to submit their awardees not later than January 8, 2020 to give ample time for the in-charge to encode the names of the awardees. Names of Awardees shall be sent to EPISA Ma. Grace B. Kim to facilitate fast tracking and be responsible in ensuring that all implementers deserving for the award shall be recognized. Awardees are advised to wear formal attire.
6. There will be two meals and two snacks to be served during the activity. First meal will be breakfast of January 16, 2020 and the other will be lunch.
7. Relative to this activity, travelling expenses of the Education Program Specialists in ALS and Focal Person shall be charged against division funds subject to usual accounting rules and regulations while ALS implementers shall be charged against their usual yearly allowance.

### Mechanics of the Contest:

#### A. ALS Quiz Bee

1. There shall only be one (1) learner per cluster per A & E program.
2. The Quiz master shall ask 5 questions for the Easy Round with options, 5 questions for the Average Round with options, 5 questions for the Difficult Round with no options and at least 5 questions for the Clincher Round and must be used in case of tie.
3. The quiz master shall read each question twice and the time shall start only after the quiz master says "go". After hearing the word, the contestant must begin to answer.
4. The contestant must write his/her final answer on the Show Me Board. If a contestant wishes to change his/her answer, the contestant must erase his/her answer provided he/she meets the required allotted time.
5. All answers must be spelled correctly to be considered correct.
6. Point will be given per question. One (1) point per correct answer for the easy, 3 points per correct answer for the average round, 5 points per correct answer for the difficult round. The total score of a contestant after three rounds shall be his/her score. The contestants with the highest number of points shall be declared the winner.
7. In case of tie after the Difficult Round, 1 clincher question shall be given afterwards and the first one to get the correct answer shall be declared winner.

#### B. Poster Making Contest

1. Poster must be original and must evolve around the theme
2. The medium to be used in the contest is pastel
3. ½ illustration board
4. Duration of the contest shall not to exceed 1 hour
5. Finished outputs should not contain label or name that may identify the contestant and his/her cluster. No borderline. Pencil can be used for sketching. No markers.
6. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable. No appeal will be entertained after the announcement of winners.
