SUBJECT : **EMERGENCY SERVICE TRAINING CORPS (ESTC)**

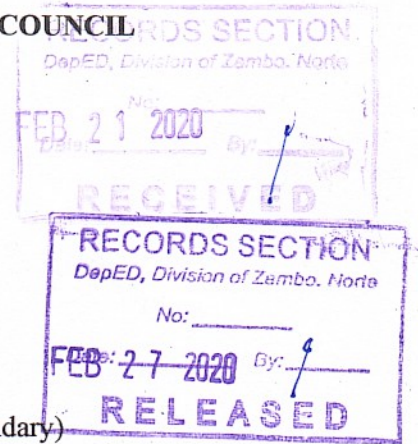
