Regional Cascading of the Teaching Grammar Communicatively for Junior High School Teachers in English Language

- 1. The National Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) and the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) announce the conduct the Regional Cascading of the Teaching Grammar Communicatively for Junior High School Teachers in English Language on July 21-23, and 26-28, 2021 via MS Teams.
- The Regional Cascading follows a training-workshop methodology which aims to:
 - a) Provide English language teaching and instructional support to teachers;
 - b) Address the needs of teachers in providing pedagogies in teaching grammar adaptive to blended, online, modular, TV-based, and radio-based learning modalities; and
 - Demonstrate various activities in teaching grammar communicatively.
- 3. Target participants to this training-workshop are the selected English Junior High School teachers who are expected to cascade the knowledge that they will gain through Learning Action Cells (LACs). Kindly see the Annex A. List of Participants for more details. Participants are required to pre-register through this link http://bit.ly/r9-training-reg072121. The MS Teams meeting link, ID, and passcode for this activity will be sent to them through their DepEd e-mail not later than July 19, 2021.
- 4. Participants should use their personal DepEd account in logging into their MS Teams. This is for easy distribution during the breakout sessions.
- Participants are advised to use their laptop and must have access to strong Internet connection. Their communication expenses for this activity shall be charged to school MOOE/ local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. Teaching participants shall be allowed for six-day service credits since the activity falls in a vacation, while non-teaching participants shall receive CTO.
- 7. This training is composed of six sessions with eight breakout rooms per session. All participants will be electronically transferred to a specific Breakout Room assigned to them.

No participants shall be allowed to transfer to another breakout room as this is ONLY determined by the Training Management Team.

- 8. If the participants wished to discontinue his/her participation to this training, he/she should inform in writing the Training Management Team through his/her Division Education Program Supervisor stating his/her justifications. If found valid, he/she will receive a Certificate of Attendance only for the days he/she was present. If reasons were found unsubstantial, the participant should complete all the required sessions and finish the specific assignments.
