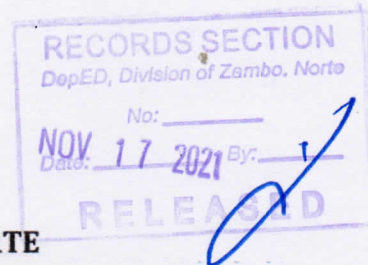

TINIG NG PANALANGIN: SONG WRITING CONTEST 2021

Tinig ng Panalangin: Song Writing Contest 2021 is the first edition of song writing competition to organized by the Schools Division of Zamboanga del Norte through the Youth Formation Section. It is one of the highlight events in the 2021 National Student Day Celebration. This event showcases the artistry and creativity of expression our learners into their daily journey, self-discovery and relationship with the Almighty through writing song.

The competition is open for bonafide learners in secondary schools of Schools Division of Zamboanga del Norte. A contestant may submit only 1 entry as a collaboration. Entry must be an original work of the contestant and all rights, including copyright to the entry must be owned exclusively by the contestant. Lyrics maybe in Filipino, English or local dialect (Subanen / Bisaya) in all its length.

The melody and lyrics of an entry, once submitted shall be final and may not be altered or modified prior to selection process. An entry may consist of any musical arrangement including acapella except hard rock, reggae and heavy metal genre. The song must not exceed 5 minutes inclusive of intro and extro. Entries will be submitted to the Schools Division Office of Zamboanga del Norte, Youth Formation section email: yfs.zdn@deped.gov.ph not later than 25 November 2021.

The contestant must submit the following **per entry**:

- a) Entry form
- b) Lyrics of the musical composition;
- c) Mp3 file of the musical composition;
- d) Photo of the contestant
- e) Parent consent

Failure to comply with any of the requirements shall be ground for disqualification.

All entries are deemed to be property of the respective contestant/s, subject to rights of DepEd the contestant agrees to grant DepEd and Schools Division of Zamboanga del Norte to publish and use part or whole form of the composition free of charge for its future undertakings.

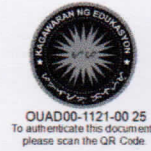
Contest categories:

Each district will have a maximum of 2 group contestants (distributed for each category). Contestant must attend the virtual opening event of the song-writing contest on 19 November 2021, 1:30PM.

Winners will be announced by 29 November 2021 for special awarding ceremony.

Subject: **VIRTUAL CELEBRATION OF NATIONAL STUDENTS' DAY 2021**


