: EMERGENCY SERVICE TRAINING CORPS (ESTC)

- We are pleased to announce that the Zamboanga del Norte Dipolog Dapitan City Council Boy Scouts of the Philippines will conduct the Emergency Service Training Corps (ESTC) on December 18 – 23, 2021 at the BSP Scout Camp, Compra, Liloy, Zamboanga del Norte.
- The Emergency Service Program is the contribution of Scouting to Community defence against the distinctive effects of disaster. The program is auxiliary for the community service component of Service Scouting.
- 3. It may well be noted that action does not happen during emergency only but during the normal times as well. Activities such as traffic services providing manpower on government programs and projects doing community service and information drive, especially on public safety and prevention can keep the Emergency Service Corps (ESC) in active duty any given situation.
- 4. The ZANDIDAP Council and the Department of Education Zamboanga del Norte Division, organize and maintain a corps of Senior Scouts as early responder group to serve the people in time of disasters and civil disturbances. This training is compulsory and exclusively for the Scouts who achieve and working for their advancement rank.
- 5. Considering that only fifty (70%) of the seating or venue capacity is allowed by the Local IATF, our training is limited to fifty (50) participants.
- 6. Hereunder are other pertinent information about the course:
 - 6.1 Qualification for admission open to the lower ranks and compulsory to Outdoorsman, Venturer & Eagle Scout Rank:
 - Must be currently registered and physically fit as certified by a Physician
 - Parent Consent
 - > and endorsement of the School Principal
 - 6.2 Course Fee: One Thousand Pesos Php 1, 000.00 per participant to cover for meals, snacks, ESC patch, Training Materials/Supplies and other administrative expenses. Registration fee can be chargeable to Local School Board Special Education Fund (LSB SEF), subject to usual accounting and auditing procedure. DepEd DBM DILG joint Circular No. s. 2020 re: Revised Guidelines on the Use of the Special Education Fund (SEF).
 - What to bring: the Scouts and Adult Leaders are encouraged to bring the following
 - Current BSP Membership Card
 - > Face Mask and Face Shield
 - Hand Sanitizers
 - Camping tent, rain coat, rope and survival kit
 - Current BSP membership IDs
 - > Type A and Type B Uniform
 - ➢ Black Leather Shoes w/ shoe laces
 - Sportswear and personal accessories
 - ➢ Scout Knife/Bolo
 - > Toiletries and others
 - Flashlight (battery/solar)
 - Extra cloth good for 7 days
 - Notebook and ballpen
