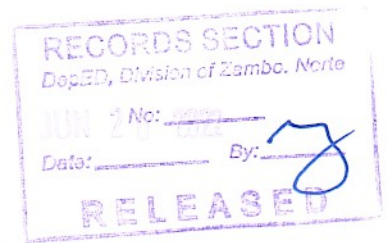

SUBJECT: DATA GATHERING OF WASH IN SCHOOLS(WinS) RESEARCH

DATE: June 20,2022

1. Hygiene and sanitation are essential to good health. Adequate water supply and adequate toilet and proper handwashing facilities are required to achieve good hygiene and sanitation. The lack of access to these facilities poses risk to people's health. However, the mere presence of these facilities is not enough to achieve better hygiene and sanitation among schools and in the community members. Proper and correct practices in the use of these facilities must be practiced maximizing the benefits and achieve the impact to the well- being of the community.
2. Guided by the foregoing premises,the Division of Zamboanga del Norte will be conducting a Research in Wash in Schools Program entitled" A SURVEY AND EVALUATION OF THE SCHOOLS AND LEARNING CENTERS" targeting all ZERO- and ONE-STAR rating schools in the districts.
