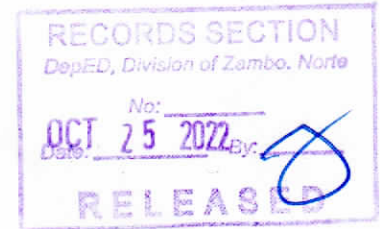



5. promote evidence-based actions to prevent and eventually stop further road traffic deaths and injuries
