- 1. The United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) and Action Against Hunger (AAH) are jointly implementing the project entitled "National Roll-out of Philippine Approach to Sustainable Sanitation (PhATSS) and Integrated Program Modelling in Zamboanga del Norte. The main objective of the project is to ensure that all children, adolescents, and women have inclusive access to age-appropriate, culturally sensitive, gender responsive and resilient WASH services, both at home and at school.
- 2. Relative to this, the Schools Division of Zamboanga del Norte will conduct a Field Monitoring and Consultation on the Results of the Three Star Approach (TSA) on August 18, 2022, for Kalawit and Godod Districts, and August 19,2022 for Sibuco District.
