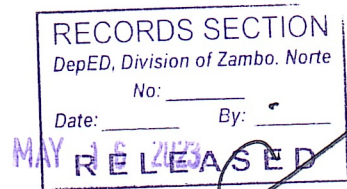

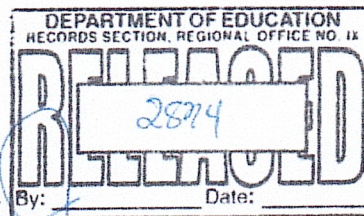
1. In prior to the said activity, a one-day (1) virtual orientation of the 2023 Division MUSABAQA Mechanics and Guidelines for Division Category officials, Technical Working Committees, Coaches and Judges to be led by the Over-All Chairperson and shall be conducted on **May 23, 2023** at 8:30 AM, Tuesday. Google Meeting link shall be disseminated later.
2. All District and Cluster Heads are advised to lead in the district and cluster level selection respectively which shall be conducted before the division level MUSABAQA, adopting the mechanics of the six (6) categories of the **2023 DIVISION MEP MUSABAQA** attached to this memorandum. Only the **CHAMPION** in each category from each cluster level competition shall represent the division level activity. Compensatory Timed-Off or service credits for 3 days shall be granted to all during the conduct of the said activities.
3. Pursuant to Division Memorandum No. 140, s. 2023 the Cluster-Districts MEP MUSABAQA are identified as follows:
  - Cluster MEP 4** – Sindangan Central, Bacungan, Godod, Salug II, Salug II, and Kalawit Districts
  - Cluster MEP 5** – Liloy I. Liloy II and Labason Districts
  - Cluster MEP 6** – Baliguian, Siocon, Sirawai and Sibuco Districts

Dinner as first meal will be served on **June 3, 2023** and PM snacks on **June 5, 2023**. Registration will start at 12:30 PM to 1:00 PM and an Opening Program will follow at exactly 1:30 PM on **June 3, 2023**. TWG are advised to be at the venue on **June 2, 2023** as an advance party for preparation and decoration.



**General Guidelines of the Regional Musabaqah**

1. The Skills Exhibition is open to all learners attending ALIVE classes in the Public Schools and ISAL in the Private Madaris / schools.
2. Participants should have registered and complied with the following requirements prior to the activity.
  - a) Certification as winner in Division Musabaqah
  - b) Parent's Consent
  - c) NSO Birth Certificate
  - d) Accomplished Entry Form
  - e) SF 5 (Form 137)
  - f) Medical Certificate
  - g) School ID
3. Any participants who fails to comply with the requirements and the qualifications specific to each category shall be disqualified.
4. Filled out entry form should be submitted at least two weeks before the conduct of the activity.
5. The participants shall be given a control number to control the division they represent.
6. Each division shall provide one (1) Judge for the different event and will inhibit participation during the performance of his/her school division.
7. Winners in each category shall receive medals, trophy. All participants shall receive a certificate of participation.
8. Winning coaches shall receive a certificate of recognition. Champions for individual and group event shall be awarded with a plaque of recognition. Non - winning coaches will be given certificate of participation.
9. Division shall be rank base on the accumulated points gathered in all the events and shall be selected as the top 3 divisions for overall winners. They shall be awarded a plaque of recognition.
10. Only the official coaches can file an appeal to the Grievance Committee.
11. The decision of the judge is final and irrevocable.

**Guidelines on the Computation of ranking and placement of Over-All Winners**

1. There will be 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place to be awarded to overall winners.
2. Placement will be determined by ranking score. The total score will be ranked according to the place they fall within each individual category.

2.1 Ranking points are as follows.

For Individual Category

- 1<sup>st</sup> place; 3 points
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place: 2 points
- 3<sup>rd</sup> place: 1 point

For Team Categories with 2-3 participants per division

- 1<sup>st</sup> place: 6 points
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place: 4 points
- 3<sup>rd</sup> place: 2 points

<b>PERFORMANCE STANDARD</b>	The learner demonstrates oral fluency on Arabic phonemes, phonetics, and alphabets by pronouncing the letters correctly with speed and accuracy through cognition and psychomotor.

<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	<p><b>Harf Touch</b> is an NFOT event category of Musabaqah that allows blind-folded learner-participants to touch the surface of the illustration board with engraved Arabic letters. Learner-participants are expected to identify, recognize, and pronounce Arabic letters correctly with speed and accuracy within the allotted time.</p> <p>This activity enhances familiarization of the Arabic letters by employing cognition and psychomotor skills.</p>
<b>CRITERIA FOR PRESENTATION</b>	There shall be one (1) point given for every Arabic letter that is correctly identified and pronounced by learner-participants.

**EVENT RULES AND MECHANICS**

- There shall be one (1) Grade One (1) learner-participant, ages 6-7 years old from Grade 1 (male or female) per region.
- Participants shall be seated at the designated holding area.
- Participants shall take turns on stage to identify the letters engraved/cut on illustration board within one minute. The facilitator shall mix the 28 letters as they take their turns.
- There shall be one (1) timekeeper/buzzer, one (1) recorder, one (1) tabulator.
- Timekeeper shall signal the start and the end of time allotted for each participant.
- Participants with correct answers and their corresponding time shall be flashed on the screen.
- The whole proceedings shall be recorded.

- E. Participants shall be seated on the floor with book stand and using a microphone in the actual reading of the selected Surrah
- F. Reading of the selected Surrah shall be done within five (5) minutes.

Description	Arabic Spelling Exhibition is one of the exciting features for the Muslim learner to showcase their listening and writing skills in Arabic Language by means of forming words from letters.
Objectives	This category aims to showcase learner's skills on the following: 1. Spell Arabic words quickly, accurately and with comprehension; and 2. Write the words correctly in its NUSKHAH and cursive form with complete vowels.
Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 12 x 18 white board</li> <li>• White Board Marker and Eraser</li> <li>• Bell/Buzzer</li> </ul>

**A. Mechanics**

- There shall be two (2) participants, ages nine to eleven (9-11) years old from levels II and II (male or female).
- The spelling exhibition shall be categorized into three (3) rounds, namely easy, average, and difficult.
- The medium of instruction to be used is Arabic Language.
- There shall be ten (10) words for each category. For EASY round (Noun with 3 syllables) AVERAGE round (Noun with 4 syllables) and DIFFICULT round (Noun with 5 syllables).
- Each word shall be read twice, the participants shall write their answer in NUSKHAH and cursive form. In ten (10) seconds for easy round, fifteen (15) seconds for average and thirty (30) seconds for the difficult round on the whiteboard provided. The Team participants shall immediately raise their whiteboard after the buzzer.
- After each round is done, the scores will be totaled.
- The three team participants with highest points win. They will be declared first, second and third winners. In case of tie in any of the top three ranks, clincher round shall be given by board of judges to determine in the place/rank from which the tied.

#### 4. Islamic Values Quiz Bee

Description	Islamic Quiz Bee shall test the learner's knowledge and understanding on the cultures, traditions, practices and belief that promotes peace and answering questions derived from Islamic Values Education subject.
Objectives	This category aims to showcase learner's the skills on the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Mastery level of Muslim learners on the content of Islamic Values Education, and</li><li>2. Display the value of unity, and sportsmanship among Muslim learners.</li></ol>
Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Show-me whiteboard</li><li>• Marker and Pen</li><li>• Timer</li><li>• Bell/Buzzer</li></ul>

##### A. Mechanics

- There shall be three (3) participants ages 6-11 years old, should from level I, II, and III (male or female)
- The officials for this category are the quizmaster, proctors, timekeeper, and recorder.
- There shall be three (3) rounds of questions namely easy, average, and difficult rounds. The easy round shall have ten (10) questions at one (1) point each. The average round shall have five (5) questions at two (2) points each. The difficult round shall have five (5) questions with three (3) points each.
- Questions in the easy and average round should be multiple choice in nature with 4 letter options. Difficult round questions have no options; thus, the team shall write the correct answers on the show-me board. Wrong spelling in both English and Arabic is wrong. If answers are written in Arabic, its must be in NUSHKA form with complete vowel.
- The correct spelling of the transliterated words shall be based on how it was written in the ALIVE curriculum and textbooks.
- The coverage of the questions in the Easy rounds is in Level I textbooks, Average round is in Level II textbooks and the difficult and clincher is in Level III textbook.

- Each of the questions shall be read twice by the quizmaster. After the second reading, the quizmaster will say "GO". The team then will write their answers in the whiteboard within ten (10) seconds for easy questions and average rounds and twenty (20) seconds for difficult round.
- When the time is up, the timekeeper rings the bell/buzzer. The team they shall stop answering and show their answer to the proctor by raising their show-me board.
- The proctor will read the answer of each team and record in the tally board and tally sheet.
- After each round, points will be tabulated. The final scores will be tabulated after the difficult round.
- The three (3) team with the highest points win. They will be declared as first, second, and third place winners respectively.
- In case of tie, a clincher round shall be given. The first one to give the correct answer shall be the winner. If no team is able to give the correct answer, another clincher question shall be given until a winner comes up.

5. **Qur'an Memorization (HIFDHUL QUR'AN)**

Description	The exhibition will showcase the memorization skills of the learners. It is composed of three rounds (easy average & difficult). The chapter from the Holy Qur'an Will be used as the material in the contest as it is the source of culture, tradition and practices which is acceptable to all Muslims.
Objectives	This exhibition category aims to showcase learner's skills on the following: 1. Identify the chapter (Surah) 2. Complete the missing verse (ayah) 3. Recite the memorized chapter (surah) following the rules of tadjweed and tawassut 4.
Materials	Verses from Holy Qur'an (Rasmul Uthmaniy)

**A. Mechanics**

- There shall be one (1) participant ages seven to nine (7-9) years old from Level II (male or female)
- The coverage of the exhibition includes Surah Al-Maun, Al-Quraysh, Al Feel, Al-Huzamah, At-Takathur, Al-Qari'ah and Al-Adiyah. Each surah shall be drawn by the assigned committee.
- The skills exhibition will consist of easy, average and difficult rounds.
  - For easy round, the judge will read the verse of the Holy Qur'an. The participants will identify the surah.
  - For the average round, the participant shall supply the missing phrase of the verse after being read by the judge.
  - For the difficult round the participant will pick the surah and deliver the verse.
- The three participants with the highest scores shall be declared first, second and third place.

Description	Adzan is an act of calling the Muslims ( Islam believers to perform a Salah (prayer)
Objectives	This exhibition aims to showcase the ALIVE learner's skills on the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Demonstrate the skills in performing the Adzan as it is done in the masjid.</li> <li>2. Proper pronunciation and chanting with clarity of voice.</li> </ol>
Materials/ Attire	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Microphone with stand</li> <li>• Muslim attire (Jubah/thawb); with tutob</li> <li>• Stopwatch</li> <li>• Bell/ Buzzer</li> </ul>

**A. Mechanics**

- There shall be one (1) participant ages six to twelve (6-12) years old from any level (male)
- The participants shall be given a control number to conceal the division they represent.
- The participant performs the Adzan verbally in a maximum of five (5) minutes including the preparation. Zero point five (0.5) will be deducted from the total score if time exceeds.
- The protocol (one of the judges) shall say IBDA (start), then, the participant begins to perform the adhan and may opt to stop when bell/buzzer rings.
- There shall be first, second, and third winners to be declared. In case of tie in any of the top three ranks, clincher round shall be given by board of judges to determine in the place/rank from which they tied.
- There shall be one (1) timekeeper, one (1) recorder, one (1) tabulator and three (3) panel of judges.
- The timekeeper shall ring the buzzer to end the allotted time.
- The time recorder and tabulator shall record the time and tally the scores.
- The decision of the judges is final.
- The appeal of the official coach shall only be accommodated and address to the grievance Committee.
