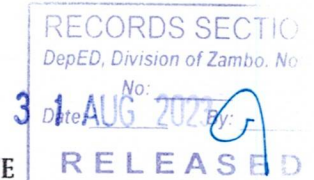

**PROGRAM READ'OKE FOR STRUGGLING READERS IN
GRADE 2 TO SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS**

TO: All Public Schools District Supervisors/PICDs
Elementary and Secondary School Heads
English Teachers (Elementary & Secondary)

1. This is to inform the field of another reading program anchored on ilove2read (Elem) and CARE and SHARE (Secondary), dubbed as READ'OKE. This is intended for the struggling readers, whose classification is to be done after the results of the Division Diagnostic Test have been determined, which is to be conducted during the opening of classes. The program READ'OKE from grade 2 up to Senior High School will commence effective School Year 2023-2024.
2. The program "READ'OKE" aims to:
 - a. determine the effectiveness of singing while reading which led to the development of the reading skill;
 - b. provide printed song lyrics as reading materials;
 - c. gather videoke type multimedia materials that will be used as springboards in enhancing learners' reading skills;
 - d. apply DOOR assessment strategies while singing utilizing the DOOR electronic assessment tool in computing their score in WORD READING and
 - e. compute the COMPREHENSION LEVEL by asking 1 or 2 questions about the song.
3. The respondents to this program are all the Grade 2 up to Senior High School struggling readers upon the recommendation of the classroom advisers based on the results of the diagnostic test. Songs are wonderful memory tools and that is why almost every commercial in the radio or television has music or jingle as background. Psychologists say, it's no surprise that we have such strong memory for music and can easily recall lyrics and melodies.
4. A monthly evaluation on the learners reading ability through singing while reading will be monitored and checked. Monthly reports are expected from the schools reflecting the struggling readers' development to be submitted to the Division Office with copies to be retained in the classrooms and consolidated data to be retained in the principals' office as well as in the district office.


