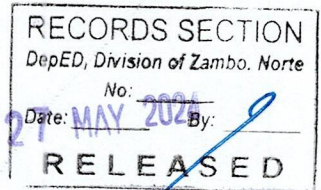

The Philippine Institute for Development Studies (PIDS), through the Asian Social Project Services, Inc., (ASPSI), will conduct the **2024 Comprehensive Socio-Economic Survey from April to June 2024** in 31 randomly selected cities/municipalities nationwide, with study sites comprising 180 barangays across 25 provinces.


