SUSTAINABILITY OF THE DIVISION ONE ON ONE READING (DOOR) IMPLEMENTATION - ENHANCED

Assistant Schools Division Superintendents To: Chiefs, CID and SGOD **Education Program Supervisors All Public Schools District Supervisor Concerned School Heads Reading Coordinators**

In line with the DepEd's MATATAG agenda which is to make the 1. curriculum relevant to produce competent, job-ready, active and responsible citizens, the National Reading and Mathematics Programs are recently introduced titled, Pagbasa at Pagkuwenta: Pag-asa (P3) which seek to create a sustainable approach to enhancing learners' knowledge, skills and attitudes.

Specifically, Division Memorandum No. 66, s. 2023, all the elementary and secondary schools conducted DOOR during the School Year 2023-2024 to monitor the struggling learners' progress in reading. This is to announce that DOOR will be enhanced this year to be known as Enhanced DOOR (e-DOOR), with the parents' involvement. This is better enhanced this school year with the creation of Project OTUC where the teachers can access the TV units for the READ'OKE, which is as strategy in the implementation of the DOOR and e-DOOR that will commence in the 2nd week of October S.Y. 2024-2025.

- The objectives of the e-DOOR are to: 2.
 - a. involve the parents in the program to give them equal opportunities with their children;
 - b. promote READ'OKE as a strategy to DOOR that will allow real time reading experiences among the parents and learner;
 - c. provide quality time to the parent-child tandem to sing together to read and to read together to sing;
 - d. actualize the teaching of reading to the parents as a way of motivating their children to read too; and
 - e. equip the reading teachers with the set of electronic tools (e-tools) through this link depedzn.net/link/ZNtemplatesEnglish to facilitate the DOOR /e-DOOR administration.







This e-DOOR program will start its implementation among the four (4) 3. selected pilot schools which are the two (2) elementary schools and two (2) high schools to find out the result of the actual program implementation. On the other hand, all the other schools are expected to continue the program without the parents yet. (Refer to the enclosure as regards the Guidelines relative to the DOOR/e-DOOR implementation. It is expected that feedback on the implementation of these programs will be submitted to the division office through a monitoring tool.

The following schools with numerous merits in terms of reading program implementation are the chosen pilot implementers:

Elementary Level:

- Salug Central School Salug 1 District
- Sindangan Pilot Demonstration School Sindangan Central District

High School:

- Sibutad National High School
- Rizal National High School
- The e-tools that were previously utilized in the original DOOR hold true 4. for the parent-child tandem as well as the different strategies stipulated in the Division Memorandum No. 338 s. 2021. This is a package to cure the problem of struggling readers, if implemented well. This memorandum will take effect after the results of the 2024-2025 Division Diagnostic Reading Test shall have been finalized.
- 5. Travel and incidental expenses of the Division Monitors shall be charged to Division Funds subject to the usual accounting, auditing rules and regulations.

4. The start of DOOR and e-DOOR actual activity is set on the second week of 2024 for the pretest. The schools are expected to group the learners homogeneously as to struggling, instructional and independent readers. The Parents who will be recipients to the e-DOOR are also expected to take the Diagnostic Reading Test for them to be identified in particular

group. The posttest will be on the first & second weeks of April, 2025. The Division Monitoring Team (DMT) will take charge of the following grade levels:

- 5. The team is expected to review the PHIL-IRI tool or the summarized idea presented in the Diagnostic Test in Reading (per Division Memorandum to be issued which will be conducted during the opening classes). In the one-on-one reading, each monitor will use any of the PHIL-IRI passages for the corresponding grade level.
- 6. After the activity of the entire district, deliberation will take place. The 2 principals (elementary and secondary) together with the team members are expected to analyze the results and to input/upload the data on the following template through these links:


