Alaba, via email at wincymae.alaba@deped.gov.ph, cc: region9.essd@deped.gov.ph for validation and submission to the Central Office.
- 5. Moreover, for ease of access, all enclosures can be accessed through this link: https://link.rog-deped.com/LRPEnclosures. The deadline for the submission of all the reports is on **August 9, 2024.**
- 6. In view of the foregoing, all consolidated data shall be maintained and protected at all costs and under all circumstances, in compliance with Republic Act (RA) No. 10173, otherwise known as the Data Privacy Act.


