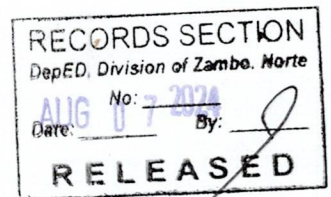

**CALL FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE 12TH WESTERN MINDANAO
REGIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE**

To: Public Schools District Supervisors/Principals In-Charge

1. In reference to BSP Council Office Memorandum No. 06, s. 2024, the BSP Western Mindanao Region in coordination with BSP Zamboanga del Norte – Dipolog – Dapitan City Council shall conduct the **12th Western Mindanao Regional Scout Jamboree** on **August 23 – 26, 2024** at **Kampo Pabibo, Brgy. Mawal, Leon B. Postigo, Zamboanga del Norte**. The Local Council is contemplating to send around 2,000 delegates.
2. In this connection, all District Scout Commissioners, Institutional Heads, BSP Coordinators and Unit Leaders are encouraged to support the said activity, being the host Schools Division Office.
3. Each School-District of the Schools Division of Zamboanga del Norte shall have at least **one (1) BSP Troop and one (1) BSP Outfit**.
4. All expenses incurred by the participants shall be charged against the local funds/MOOE/SEF, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing procedures.
5. For the services rendered on Saturday and Sunday, teaching and non-teaching participants are entitled to Compensatory Time Off (CTO) or Service Credits whichever is applicable for the employee in accordance with CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on **Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered** or DO 53, S. 2003, titled **Updated Guidelines in the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers**.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

SUBJECT : **12th WESTERN MINDANAO REGIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE**

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines Western Mindanao Region is pleased to announce the holding of another historic regional event, the **12th WESTERN MINDANAO REGIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE** on **23 – 26 AUGUST 2024** at Kampo Pabibo, Brgy. Mawal, Leon B. Postigo, Zamboanga del Norte, with the **Theme: “Youth Engagement: Sustaining Relevance and Strengthening Resilience”**.
2. **Background.** This year’s most awaited Regional Scout Event happens only every two (2) years and is expecting to host more than 5, 000 Scouts and Leaders regionwide with some special guests, and participation from other region of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines.

Scouting is a global and educational youth movement that builds friendships, experiences, and skills for life, shaping young people’s futures as active citizens. Today, Scouting in the Philippine is the leading educational youth movement with over 2.7 million Scouts in over 122 councils nationwide. Through its unique combination of education, adventure and fun, Scouting continues to be an inspiration for young people to become active citizens who are engaged in creating a better and more sustainable world.

A Scout Jamboree is the “Mother of all Activities” of a Scout’s life, something every dedicated Scout and even Scout Leaders look forward to and whose memories are cherished deeply afterward. In a Jamboree, Scout expands their hearts and minds learning new things and discovering rich assortment of novel experiences. Such a gathering requires all the basic services provided by the host Municipality of Leon B. Postigo – shelter, water, market, infirmary, fire department, garbage collection and disposal, etc.

3. **Rationale.** Through the years, the Western Mindanao Region - Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) has played and continues to play a primordial role in the community and society as a youth organization that encourages and helps young people develop their individual potentials and capabilities and raise their level of awareness and importance of their responsibilities for social development.

Jamboree is learning by doing. Scouting’s approach to education is guided by the principles and fundamental beliefs on which Scouting was founded over a century ago. It aims to contribute to the empowerment of individuals and their development as active citizens in their local, national, and global communities. Guiding this process is a diverse set of competencies in the Scout Youth Programme that focus on knowledge, skills, attitudes, and values.

4. Jamboree Aim and Objectives.

The 12th WMR Regional Scout Jamboree aims to provide a progressive, exciting, challenging, safe and enjoyable learning environment for the Scouts in order to enhance their full Social, Physical, Intellectual, Character, Emotional and Spiritual potentials as an active citizen making real contribution in creating a better community.

At the end of the Jamboree, the participants should be able to:

1. Promote Scouting's highest quality standards of educational initiatives that is faithful to the vision, mission, fundamental principles and methods of Scouting and adapted to the needs and aspirations of young people;
2. Undertake high-adventure and outdoor activities that promotes active and healthy lifestyle and appreciation of nature and environment;
3. Conduct community service projects related to the current thrusts of World Scouting's Four (4) Thematic Areas of Education under the Scouting Education for Sustainable Development (1) Environment and Sustainability, (2) Peace and Community Engagement, (3) Skill for Life, and (4) Health and Well – Being.
4. Complete and satisfy the requirements for selected Merit Badges and Scout Ranks under the revised Advancement Scheme and Merit Badge System;
5. Acquire and develop core life skills and 21st century leadership capabilities through team building, cooperative learning, group dynamics, creative problem – solving and decision – making skills;
6. Increase the level of awareness and understanding about the prevailing issues on environment, human rights, mental health and well-being, education, culture and science and technology through the Global Development Village, Science and Cross Roads of Culture (Subanen History in Leon B. Postigo); and
7. Promote Sustainable Development Goals and best practices through Modules and Educational Initiatives in Scouting.

5. **Qualification for Participation.** The following are the qualifications for all participating Scouts and Adult Leaders;

a. **Boy Scout and Senior Scout**

1. Must be currently registered as Boy Scout or Senior with a Troop or Outfit;
2. Physically fit to undergo strenuous activities especially in the outdoors as certified by a licensed Physician;
3. Show leadership potentials in his/her unit and preferably a graduate of PLTC/CLTC;
4. Must be at least nine (9) to twelve (12) years old for Boy Scouts;
5. Must be at least thirteen (13) to eighteen (18) years old for Senior Scouts;
6. Secure his/her Parent's/Guardian's Consent; and
7. Must have his/her own camping gears and equipment.

b. **Troop Leader and Outfit Advisor**

1. Must be of good moral character;
2. Must be currently registered as Troop Leader or Outfit Advisor;
3. Must be Physically Fit as certified by a licensed Physician;
4. Must be a graduate of a Basic Training Course for Troop Leader/Outfit Advisor;
5. Preferably a wood badge holder;
6. Must have his/her own camping gears and equipment;
7. Must have undertaken an online introduction course from WOSM's Safe From Harm thru this link <https://www.scout.org/what-we-do/member-organizations/child-and-youth-safety>

6. **Registration Details.** Stated below are the important details regarding the Jamboree Registration System and procedure, viz:

- a. **Registration:** A Jamboree fee of **ONE THOUSAND PESOS (Php 1, 000.00)** shall be charged from each participant in order to defray administrative cost, program materials, souvenir items and other operating expenses. Deadline for the Jamboree Registration Fee on or August 15, 2024, breakdown as follows:

1. ZANDIDAP Council Delegation Activity T-shirt printed with approved 12th WMR Jamboree logo & ZANDIDAP Council
2. Jamboree Neckerchief
3. Jamboree Patch
4. Jamboree ID w/ lanyard
5. Activity Card
6. Certificate
7. and Miscellaneous


The registration fee, transportation and other incidental expenses are chargeable to SEF/Local Funds & other funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulation.

The joint circular (JC) no. 1, s. 2020 dated 27 August 2020, addendum to DepEd – DBM – DILG JC No. 1, s. 2020 entitled “Revised Guidelines on the use of the Special Education Fund (SEF), and section no. 1.2.2. “payment of expenses pertaining to the operation of Scouting Activities (Jamboree, Camping, Hiking, Outdoor Activities, Scout Trainings and instructional drills/exercises) of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines”.

7. Teachers participants shall receive Service Credits during Saturdays, Sundays and holidays subject to the provision stipulated under DECS Memorandum No. 143, s. 1997. Likewise, School Heads and non-teaching personnel shall be provided with compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) per CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 02, s. 2004.
8. **Food Provision:** Participating Districts, Units and or Institution must provide for their own food and other basic requirements that will be sufficient throughout the entire duration of the Jamboree. Each contingent is responsible in managing their respective kitchens, mess and commissaries. Wet and Dry Markets will be made available at the Jamboree Site in order to ensure the availability of food supplies at reasonable prices.
9. **Jamboree Bulletin.** The Regional and Local Jamboree Organizing Committees, thru the Regional Project Management Team of the 12th WMR Regional Scout Jamboree, will be publishing and releasing Jamboree Bulletins from time to time in order to provide everyone with the latest information and details about the Jamboree, allowing and enabling all participants to adequately prepare for the event.
10. All concerned are hereby enjoined to promote and help ensure the maximum participation of the Scouts and Adult Leaders within your respective Institution and Districts. You are further advised to organize working committees in order to support your respective Contingent Management Team (CMTs) to ensure the efficient preparation for the events and the smooth relay information and other details.
